SURF CAMP INFORMATION

DATE: Sunday 21st - 26th September 2008

TIME: Registration & Start of Camp
Sunday 21st September @ 1.30pm

PLACE: Burleigh Heads Surf Club.

Numbers are restricted so first to book and pay will be guaranteed a place on this camp.

MEMBERS OBLIGATION

Once you have gained your qualification, you will be expected to perform voluntary beach patrol duties. Currently the requirement is 6 hours per month on a rostered basis.

INSURANCE

Surf Club participants aged 15 years and over will be covered by a comprehensive Surf Life Saving Qld workcover scheme. It provides for medical costs incurred by a member if injured are sustained during a **surf lifesaving activity**. Surf Camp participants under the age of 15 are covered by Personal Accident Insurance, however federal law prohibits this Policy from paying medical expenses where a medicare component is available.

ASSISTANCE REQUIRED

Each day we will require a few parents to assist with simple meal preparations. If you can spare some time please let us know.

SUPERVISION

Qualified instructors will be in charge at all times. All instructors have a "Working with Children BlueCard".. Emphasis will be placed on team work and surf safety at all times.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The minimum age for Bronze Medallion candidates is 15 years and 13 years for Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC) candidates.

You must be capable of swimming 400 metres within 9 minutes for Bronze Medallion and 200 metres in 5 minutes for SRC candidates.

** pool swim is conducted on the first day of the camp

All successful bronze medallion participants will also be awarded a Cert 11 in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue). You can apply to have the credits recorded on you Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE). A completed Certificate II contributes 4 credits.
