Well we are back at it with a bronze squad under way and the list for the September annual Surf Camp growing. The season will again be huge with plenty going on in the training area.

First off the Proficiencies dates for this season are

Sunday 29 August

Sunday 31 October

Sunday 21 November

There will be some changes to the proficiency this season, they are:

- Pool swim to be completed with a Pool Swim Assessment Test form completed by an assessor or your swim coach – form available from the club office or the club web site - www.bhmpslsc.com.au
- Run – Swim – Run will be timed – 8 minutes
- The double tube tow introduction
- Oxy Viva and Defibrillation awareness for those members that do not have the award. Both the Oxy Viva and Defib will be utilised during the resuscitation proficiency assessments.
- The theory proficiency paper (ONLY 20 QUESTIONS) to be completed prior to the day – available from the club office and the club web site – www.bhmpslsc.com.au The theory paper, all 20 questions, is to be completed by all who are completing their proficiency regardless of the award they hold
- Radio award holders will also be required to complete a proficiency
- A Proficiency Bulletin for season 2010/11 will be very helpful to all members that will be completing their annual Proficiency – available from the club office or the club web site – www.bhmpslsc.com.au
- SLSQ are promoting that the proficiency will take 5 hours to complete, but if you have completed the theory test and are on time I'm sure it will only take 4 hours.
- IRB proficiencies will NOT be carried out with the normal proficiency they will be conducted later in the season, all those affected will be advised with details when available.

I would like to encourage members to get in early for your proficiency as the surf only gets bigger later in the season.

The surf camp will require assistance from anyone who can assist, your help will be appreciated, it starts on Sunday 19 September and the assessments on Friday 24 September. For those that wish to attend the camp for their SRC or Bronze, please complete an enrolment form which has been posted out to all U14's and first year U17's. If you do not receive this in the mail, the information and enrolment form is available to download from the club web site www.bhmpslsc.com.au - get in early!

Anyone keen to do awards let me know (complete a training request form) and I'll let you know when the courses are on but remember that they are conducted when a trainer is available and you will be required to attend the training sessions to complete the training competencies.

I have also gone through the training Certificates that have NOT been collected. The list is in this newsletter, if your name is on the list you can collect the certificate/s from the office, Mon – Fri between the hours noon – 5 pm or call Julie on 5535 2419 to arrange collection.
