Our Nippers and Seniors are also back at training under the guidance of the Clubs Coaches and all look set to have a great season. Can I remind all Members that it is imperative that membership fees are paid to ensure that you can train and are covered by insurance. So if you haven't joined up yet now is the time to do so.

### **Our Supporters Club**

The Supporters Club of the Surf Club operates the commercial activities of the Club that enables financial assistance to be provided to the Surf Club by way of donations. Welcome team to another Pipeline edition. As the season quickly approaches there is just a few things to remind you of. Firstly please make sure you call your patrol captain at least two days before if you cannot make it to patrol and it would be greatly appreciated if you could find a sub. We are a team and a team is only as strong as it weakest link. Whilst we're on patrol please ensure you are suitably attired, as in making sure you have your patrol cap, shirt and shorts on and black or club togs; females should be wearing two-piece or one-piece club togs or competition style togs. No electronic devices are to be brought to patrol including phones, iPods, MP3 etc... The reason these electronic devices should not be brought to patrol is because if you suddenly find yourself having to perform a rescue these may become water logged.

Proficiencies have started, in previous Pipelines and on the website you will find the calendar for proficiencies. Note to IRB Drivers and Crew, you will need to register with Kellie, our CTO, at least two weeks prior to do your IRB proficiency as we need the numbers in because they are being held at North Burleigh. As you have seen in pervious emails, your pool swim form and your proficiency paper need to be completed before showing up on the day. You will also need to bring your patrol or competition cap to proficiency. ATV and tractor proficiencies will be starting shortly. Notification will be sent out. For your ATV and tractor please make available at least half a day, hopefully with your co-operation we will not need all this time. There is a paper involved.

To all our budding basketballers, extreme caution needs to be adhered to as there are the general public and club members moving around and through the vicinity. So please be aware of your surroundings and other people's safety, this would be greatly appreciated.

You should have your patrol roster by now, please check it carefully and make the dates available. There will be an updated version coming out at the end of surf camp.

With 2 courses now completed and an IRB Crew and Driver course having just commenced the season is well and truly underway in the training area. Congratulations must go to the 19 Members who gained their First Aid Certificates last weekend and to Kerri-Lyn French who completed her Training Officer Award for first aid.

**Now for the future.....** I have developed a training calendar which will be uploaded to the website. The calendar contains the proposed and confirmed training dates for a number of courses, a brief synopsis of each course and the minimum requirements needed to be able to attend the course. I have also placed a copy of this calendar on the glass outside the office and on the notice board in the boat shed.

As you will see from the calendar there are a number of courses coming up within the next month including:

### **Operational First Aid (HLTFA301B – Apply First Aid)**

The next First Aid course is being held on Sunday 25 September from 8.00am until 3.00pm. I am also gauging interest for people who wish to complete the theoretical components of the First Aid Course on Thursday 22 September and Friday 23 September from 5:00pm until 9:00pm instead of attending the training on the Sunday. The assessment for both courses will be held at 4:00pm on Sunday 25 September. If you would like to attend this training please email [training@burleighslsc.com.au](mailto:training@burleighslsc.com.au) by 5:00pm on Monday 12 September. I will forward the first aid workbook to attendees soon after this date. **NOTE:** This workbook must be completed **prior** to attending the course and First Aid Manuals are available from the office.

### **BRONZE (Certificate II in Public Safety – Aquatic Rescue)**

The **Annual Surf Camp** is fast approaching and will commence this year on Sunday 18 September 2011 with the exam being held on Friday 23 September 2011. This is a one week intensive course and caters for U14 nippers through to adults (well those of us adults who can take time off work...). Another Bronze/SRC course has been scheduled to commence on Saturday 1 October 2011 at 8:00am.
