It is now time to start organising next year's trip to Perth. We have rebooked the same accommodation at South Perth, as well as 6 additional apartments nearby at Broadwater Como Resort. The cost will be slightly higher than last year and details are below. If you wish to stay with the club, **a deposit of \$100 per person is required by the 11th July**. The balance can be paid in monthly installments over the following 6 months with the full amount to be paid by the end of January 2009.

The accommodation is booked for 8 nights with **arrival on Sunday 15th March and departure on Monday 23rd March 2009**. If you require an earlier arrival or later departure date, you must let me know as early as possible as it may not be available later. Cost for additional nights will be extra. The accommodation details are as follows;

Quest on Arlington

- 7 x 2 bedroom & 16 x 3 bedroom apartments that sleep up to 4 & 6 persons, situated in South Perth, approximately 20 mins from Scarborough Beach. Full kitchen, laundry, phone, TV, Pool, Spa & BBQ. For more details go to www.arlington.property.questwa.com.au Cost for 8 nights is \$500 per person.

Broadwater Como Resort

- 6 x 2 bedroom loft apartments that sleep up to 6 persons, situated in Como near South Perth, approximately 20 mins from Scarborough Beach. Full kitchen, laundry, phone, TV, Pool, Spa, Tennis Court & BBQ. For more details go to www.como.broadwaters.com.au Cost for 8 nights is \$600 per person based on a minimum of 5 persons per room.

Please note: Deposits will be refundable up until MID DECEMBER. After this date, deposits will be refundable only if there is someone to take your place.

By all indications, we are expecting many more people to attend next year and accommodation is very limited in Perth due to 2 other major events happening at the same time as Aussies. Rooms will be allocated firstly to athletes that pay their deposit by 11th July and then on a first in first served basis.

Air Fares

It is your responsibility to book your own flights. Please note the accommodation dates above when booking as if you arrive or depart outside of these date you will have an additional cost for your accommodation. A cheaper flight a day or 2 either side may not work out cheaper in the long run.

Fundraising

Funds need to be raised to cover the cost of freight of equipment, bus hire while we are in Perth and uniforms. Any surplus to this is distributed on a pro rata basis dependant upon the time you put in to raising funds. This benefit is available to everyone that participates in fundraising. Please ensure that we have your email address so that we can advise you of upcoming activities. Anyone that would like to be on the fundraising committee or with any ideas or if you can provide prizes for raffles etc please see Julie.

The more fundraising you do, the less the trip will cost you!!!!

Freight of competition equipment

We will require 3 containers next year for all competition equipment such as boards, skis, boats, R & R reels etc and the cost of this is still to be determined. We need to know who is going so that we can calculate our freight requirements.

Transport in Perth

Buses have been booked to get us to and from the beach each day and will be available to members staying in club-arranged accommodation.

Chaperones

Any competitors under 18 and traveling without a parent **MUST** have a chaperone. Parents should arrange this themselves with another parent however if you require assistance we are only too happy to help if we can.
