Dear Patrol Member

The season for patrolling Burleigh is once again on us. Please find enclosed your patrol roster for season 2010-2011. The season commences on **18th September 2010** and finishes **2nd May 2011**. Should you have any problems with the roster or are not returning to the club this season please do not hesitate to contact me on 0402 326 750 or by email at peterwhitty@bigpond.com so that the patrol roster may be altered. All patrolling members are to be financial prior to commencement of the season so if you haven't renewed your membership now is the time to do so.

A great number of changes have been made to the patrol groups this season so do not rely on you being on the same patrol group as last season. Please check thoroughly. Please check phone numbers & advise the office of any changes.

All patrolling members over the age of 18 are required by law to hold a current "Working with Children" blue card. If you do not have a blue card or your card needs renewing please see myself, your patrol captain or the office for a form. The forms can also be downloaded from our web site www.burleighslsc.com.au and all forms must be returned to the office for processing.

Our Patrol Requirements for the season are;

- 1 Arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of your patrol to enable you to change into your patrol uniform and to sign the patrol logbook. Patrol uniforms including patrol cap must be worn at all times whilst on patrol.
- 2 First patrol of the day shall set up the patrol for the day and the last patrol will remain until all patrol equipment is cleaned and put away including the IRB.
- 3 The patrol logbook must be signed at the beginning and the end of each patrol.
- 4 If you are unable to do your patrol please obtain a substitute and inform your Patrol Captain. Remember your patrolling obligation is all your rostered patrols.
- 5 If you are doing a make up or volunteer patrol please contact the relevant Patrol Captain by the Thursday prior to the patrol so that they know how many to expect for patrol.

We advise that for all patrolling member's convenience we will be lodging the patrol roster and patrol groups on our website. If for any reason you do not wish for your personal details to be displayed please notify the office.

We thank you in anticipation of you fulfilling your patrol obligations this season. With your assistance we can continue to keep Burleigh beach fatality free.
